




Objective


- To show the students Noah's love for God and God's love and care for him.

This lesson is based on the Scripture found in Genesis 6 through 8.

Of all mankind, only a man named Noah was still honest. One day, God told him, "The end of the mankind has come, because the earth is full of their crimes. For this the other people will vanish, but I will save you.

The water covered everything, even the tallest mountains. All of the people and animals that were not on the ark died, but Noah and his family and the animals on the ark were safe.




God did not forget about Noah and his family. He sent a big wind to dry up the water on the earth. The waters began to recede.

Because of this Noah knew that the water had gone down and that plants were growing again.




Then God said to Noah, “You may leave the ark now! Let all the animals out so that they will begin to multiply and spread all around the earth.”



Noah was so happy that God had saved him and his family that he built an altar to the Lord to worship God and offered sacrifice.




God was pleased that Noah remembered to thank Him.




Then God said to Noah, “ I wish to make a covenant (promise) with people.


