






God has sent him with a message to St. Mary. He said to her, "Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women."





You are going to have a baby - a very special baby. His name will be Jesus. He will be called the Son of the Most High.




1. Read the Holy Bible daily preferably when we get up in the morning. 5 minutes to start.
