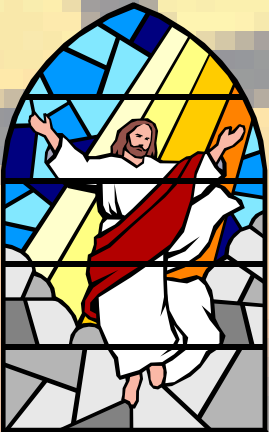

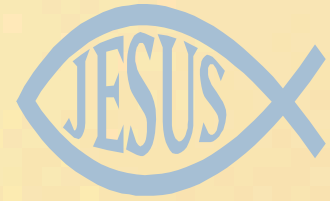

# Introduction

- **Today we are going to learn about how Jesus Christ healed a blind man.**

## **Objective**

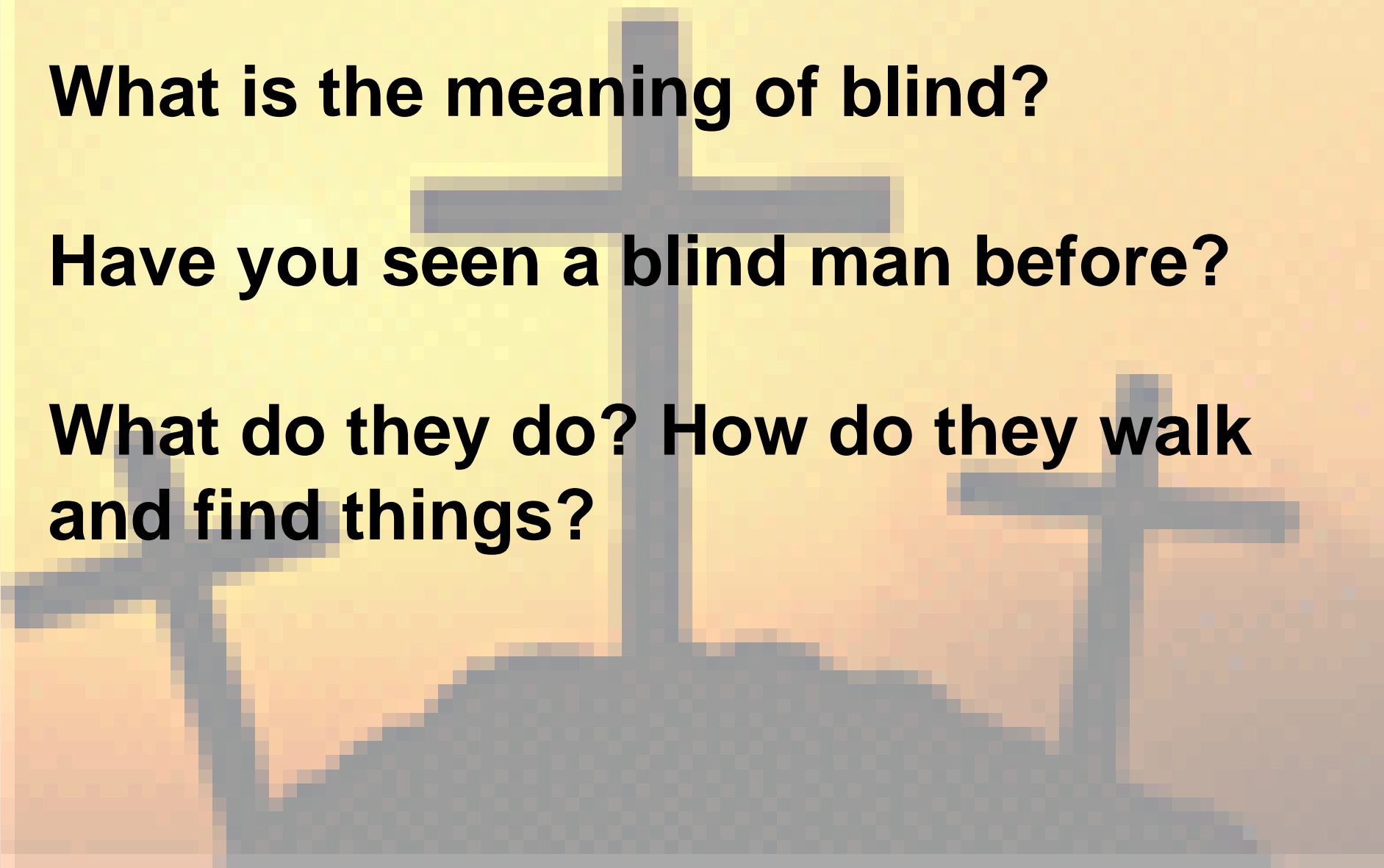
**To show Our Lord Jesus Christ's healing power.**

**Ask the children:**

**What is the meaning of blind?**

**Have you seen a blind man before?**

**What do they do? How do they walk  
and find things?**



**Once upon a time Jesus Christ was walking surrounded by many people near a city called Jericho.**

**A blind beggar was sitting and asking for money at the gate. His name was Bartimaeus. He could not work because he could not see. He can only beg. What was his name?**

**Since Bartimaeus is blind, he could not see anything. He could not see people, houses or trees.**

**He then heard the noise of the great crowd of people surrounding Jesus Christ passing by him. So, he asked what is happening? Why is there a great crowd of people, he asked, since he could not see?**



**When he heard that Jesus Christ is near, he started calling out with a loud voice**

**“*Son of David, have mercy on me*”. He kept shouting loudly “Jesus, help me”.**

**When the people heard Bartimaeus, the blind calling on Jesus Christ, they tried to quiet him down and told him to shush up....!!! And not to make noise.**

**But Bartimaeus cried out even louder to make sure that Jesus Christ would hear him.**

***“Son of David, have mercy on me”***. When Jesus heard him, He asked where is that person who is calling me? Jesus said ***“Have him come over”***.

**The people told Bartimaeus,  
come to see Jesus He is asking  
about you.**

**So, Bartimaeus the blind  
man was happy that he threw  
his coat, jumped up and asked  
the people to help him to get in  
front of Jesus.**

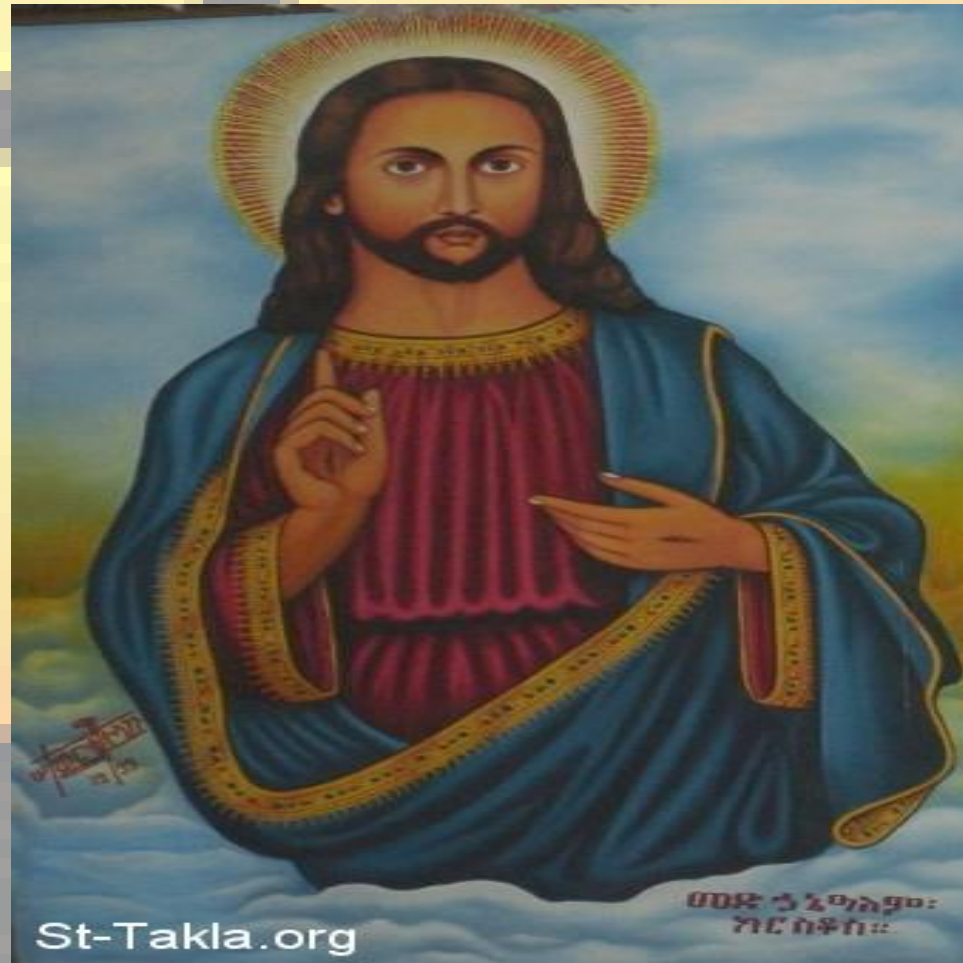
**When Jesus saw him, He asked him what do you want me to do for you? Bartimaeus said: Lord, I would like to be able to see. Then Jesus touched his eyes and immediately he was able to see.**





**Bartimaeus was very happy that he was able to see every body around him and Jesus Christ Himself in front of him. So, Jesus told him “your faith has healed you”.**

Bartimaeus **then followed** Jesus and was joyfully praising God and all the people around him were praising God too.



# Conclusion

**If we are very sure that Jesus Christ can do things for us, He will do it because Jesus Christ is strong and can do anything.**

**The blind man in the story was persistent. He did not give up. He called out again and again. He would not stop until he could talk to Jesus.**

**Do you need help with a problem? God wants to hear from you. He loves to hear your voice talking to him.**

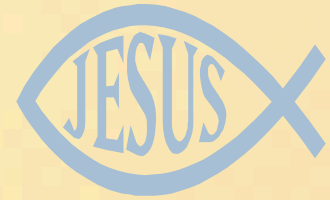

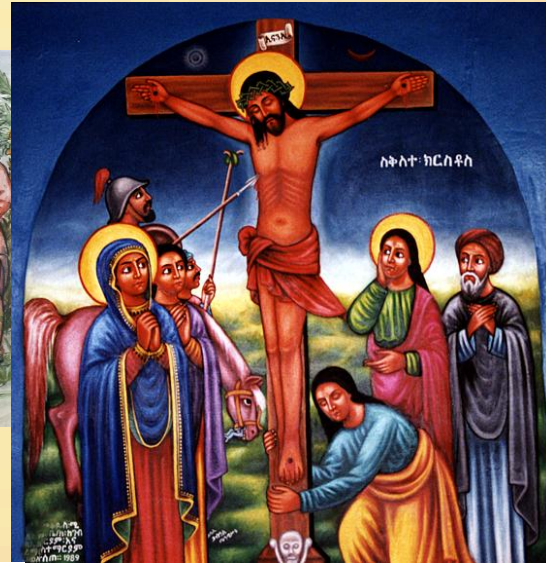
