



References:

Judges 13:1-25

 There was a certain man of the tribe of the Danites, whose name was Manoah, and his wife was barren and had no children. The man and his wife prayed all the time and asked the Lord to give them a son. The angel of the Lord appeared to Manoah's wife and said to her, "Behold you are barren and have no children, but you shall conceive and bear a son.

 Therefore beware, and drink no wine or strong drink, and eat nothing unclean, because you will have a baby son. You should not cut the hair of his head, for the boy shall be a Nazirite to God from birth".

 Then the woman came and told her husband, "A man of God came to me. I did not ask him whence he was and he did not tell me his name. Then Manoah entreated the Lord, and said, O Lord, I pray to You, let the man of God whom You sent come again to us, and teach us what we are to do with the boy that will be born".

 And God listened to the voice of Manoah, and the angel of God came again to the woman as she sat in the field, but Manoah her husband was not with her. And the woman ran in haste and told her husband, "Behold the man who came to me the other day has appeared to me",

 and Manoah arose and went after his wife and they sang the hymn, "white as white as a pigeons glittering, glittering exactly as light. O angel, how beautiful you are how sweet you are".

 And Manoah came to the man and said to him, "Are you the man who spoke to this woman?" And he said, "I am". And Manoah said, "Now when your words come true what is to be the boy's manner of life and what is he to do?" And the angel of the Lord said to Manoah, "Of all that I said to the woman let her beware.

 She may not eat of anything that comes from the vine neither let her drink, or eat any unclean thing, all that I commanded her let her observe". Manoah said to the angel of the Lord, "Pray let us detain you, and prepare sheep for you". And the angel of the Lord said to Manoah, "If you detain me I will not eat of your food, but if you make ready a burnt offering, then offer it to the Lord".

 And Manoah said to the angel of the Lord, "What is your name so that when your words come true we may honor you?" And the angel of the Lord said to him, "Why do you ask my name, seeing it is wonderful".

 So Manoah took the sheep with the cereal offering and offered it upon the rock to the Lord and when the flame went up toward heaven from the altar, the angel of the Lord ascended in the flame of the altar while Manoah and his wife looked on, and they fell on their faces to the ground.

 The angel of the Lord appeared no more to Manoah and his wife. Then Manoah knew that he was the angel of the Lord, white... white like a pigeon.

Conclusion

- Manoah used to entertain strangers so he could entertain the Lord, and offer him a sacrifice. Whenever we deprive ourselves of entertaining strangers, and when we despise the poor and the needy, we deprive ourselves of entertaining the Lord Jesus Himself.
- We can meet the Lord Jesus and entertain Him when we honor His brothers the poor, the strangers and the weak.
