Begin with the Lord's prayer

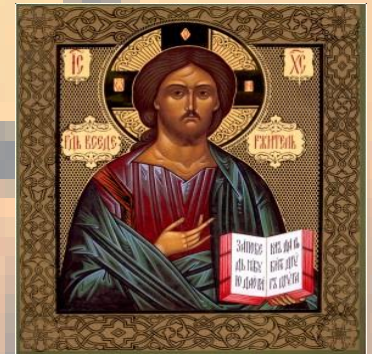
Our Lord and Savior, our King and God,

Incarnation = To take human form

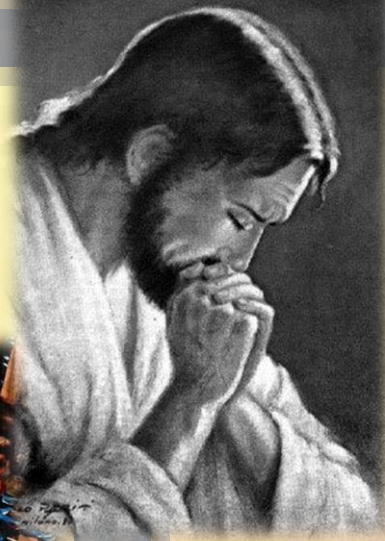
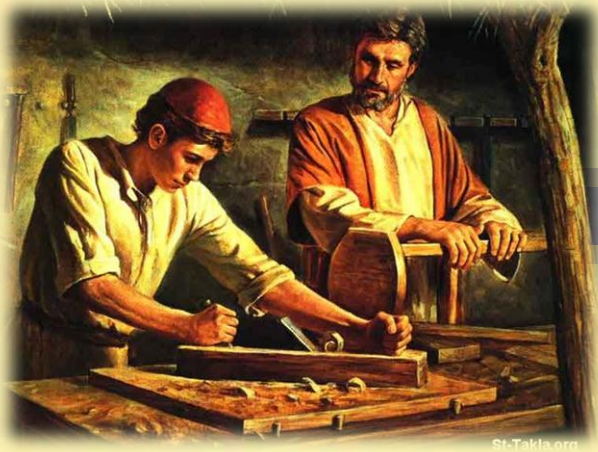


- God came down from Heaven in a human form and became man.

Out of a woman's seed comes a Savior

- Characteristics of the Savior
 - Born of a woman seed = a man
 - Must be without sin to be able to win over the evil serpent
 - He must die to be able to go to Hades and free all the righteous people waiting there.
 - He must be unlimited because the sin against God was unlimited.

- He left on the promise of preparing a heavenly place for us.



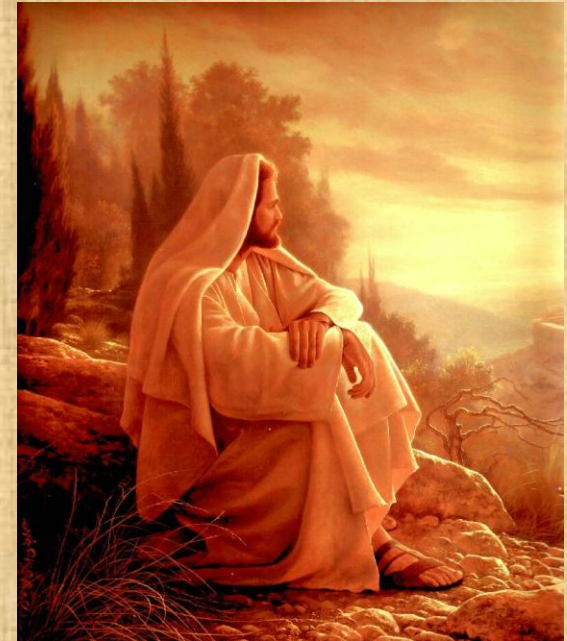
Conclusion
