Begin with the Lord's prayer

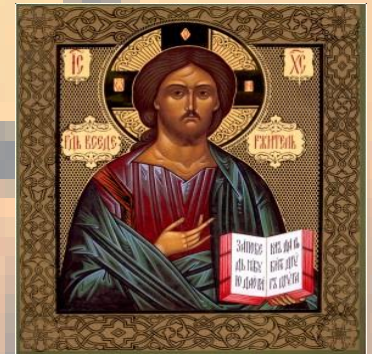
Our Lord and Savior, our King and God,

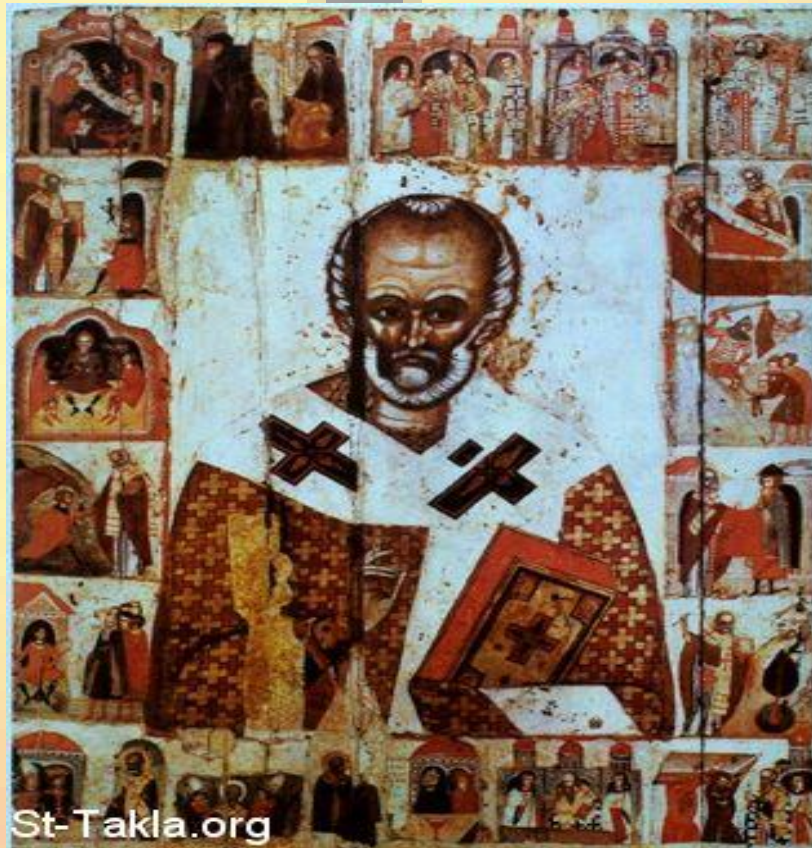

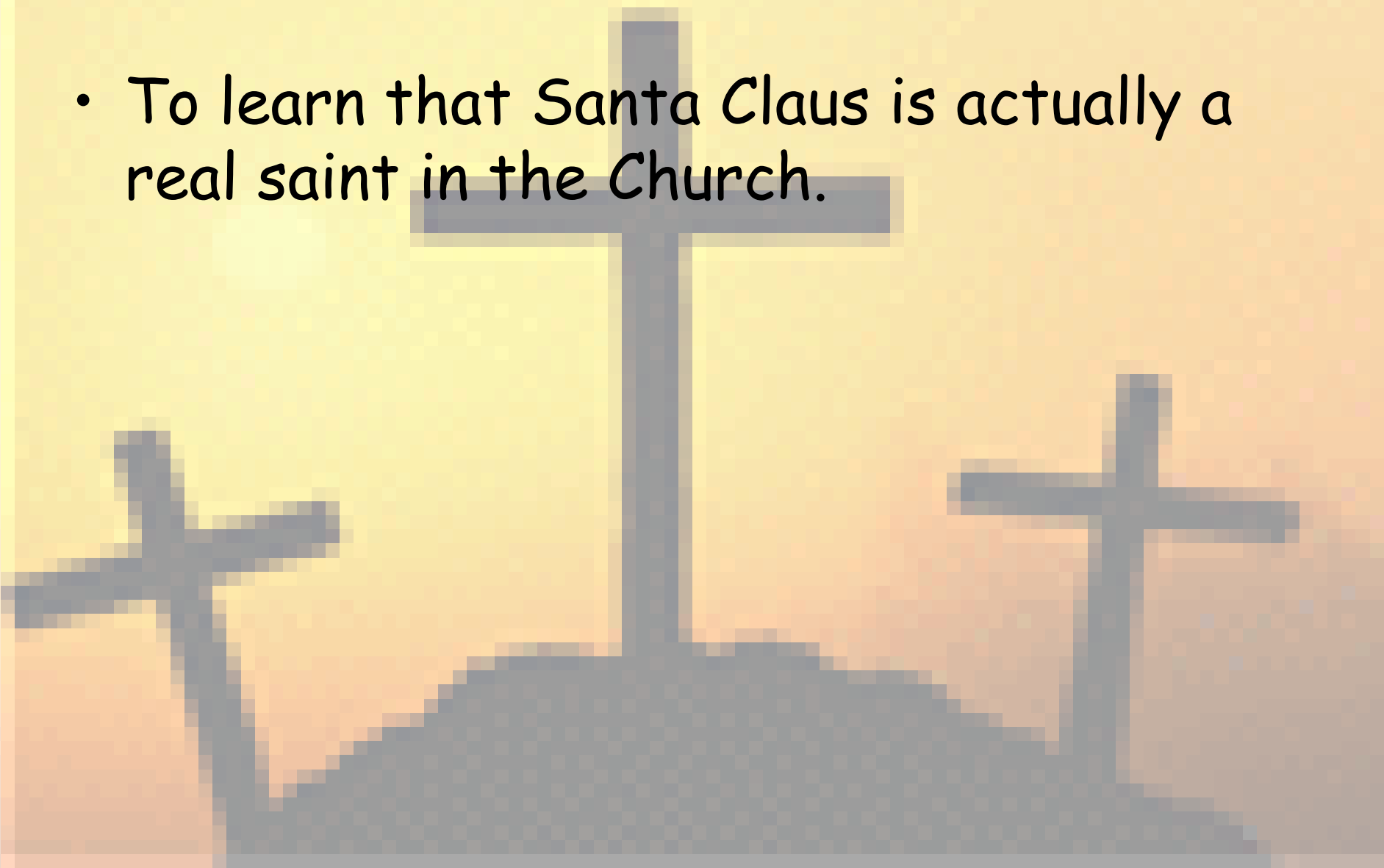

Objective

- To learn that Santa Claus is actually a real saint in the Church.



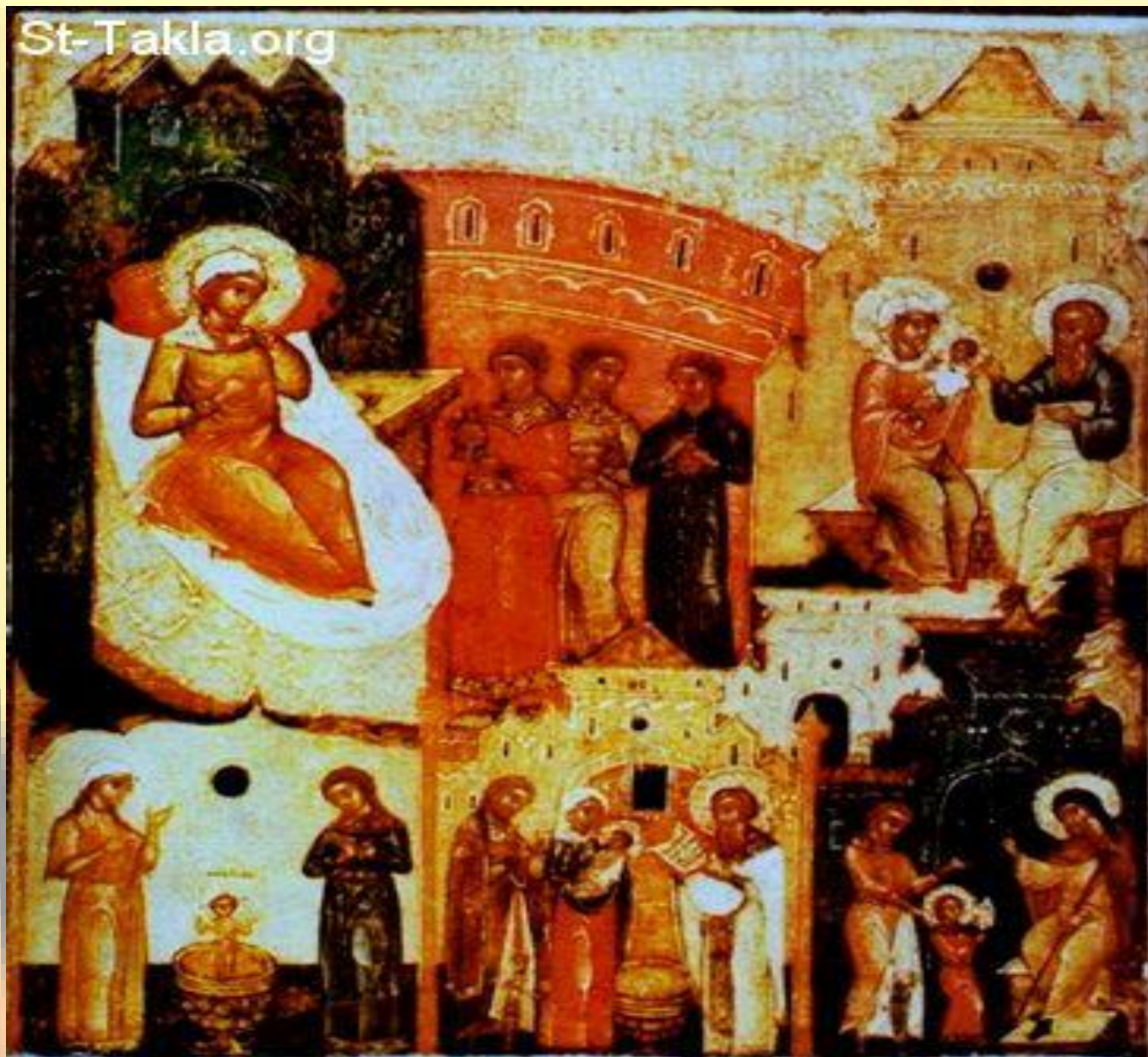
Introduction

- What do you know about Santa Claus?
 - What is the best thing about him?
- Did you know that Santa Claus = St. Nicholas ?

Santa Claus = Baba Noel = St. Nicholas

- St. Nicholas was from the city of **Mora (Myra)** in modern day Demre in Turkey
 - His father= **Epiphanius**
 - His mother= **Tona.**
- They feared the Lord
- They were rich, but with no children
- They prayed to God that they would have a child to bring them joy and inherit their money.
- God heard their prayers and gave them this saint.





Young Nicholas

- God made Nicholas Holy and Blessed him ever since he was a little boy.
- The Holy Spirit of the Lord taught and he increased in intelligence and knowledge.
- He learned all the teachings of the church since his young age and became a deacon in the church.
- He served and loved our Lord Jesus Christ.

A young monk

- He became a monk in a monastery where his cousin was the abbot.
- He became a priest at age 19. Do you know a priest who is 19 years old today???
- God gave him the gift of performing signs and healing the sick.



A famous story

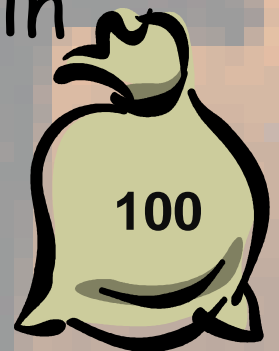
- There was a very rich man in the city of Mora who lost all his wealth.
- He had 3 daughters who passed the age of marriage.
 - However the father could not marry them off because he was poor.

A hard time

- Satan put this evil thought in the poor man's head:
 - "By letting my daughters live in sin and do evil jobs, they will have enough money for food and good way of life."
- Our Lord revealed to St. Nicholas the thoughts that were in this man's head, and he was grieved.

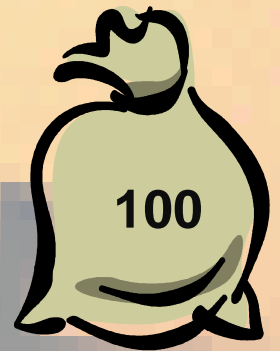
Night # 1

- St. Nicholas took **100 dinars** of his father's money and tied it up in a sack.
- During the night he threw the money into the window of the man's house.
- When the man found the money, he was astonished and rejoiced and was able to give his oldest **1st daughter** away in marriage.



Night #2

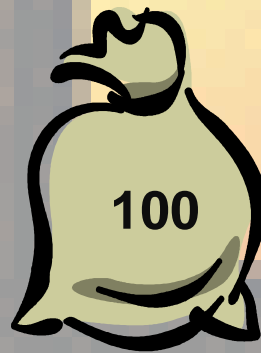
- Another night, the saint threw another **100 dinars** into the man's house.
- The man was able to give his **2nd daughter** away in marriage.
- He wondered who this charitable person was?
- He kept watch to catch him next time.

- The saint threw the gold sack into the house, but the man was watching

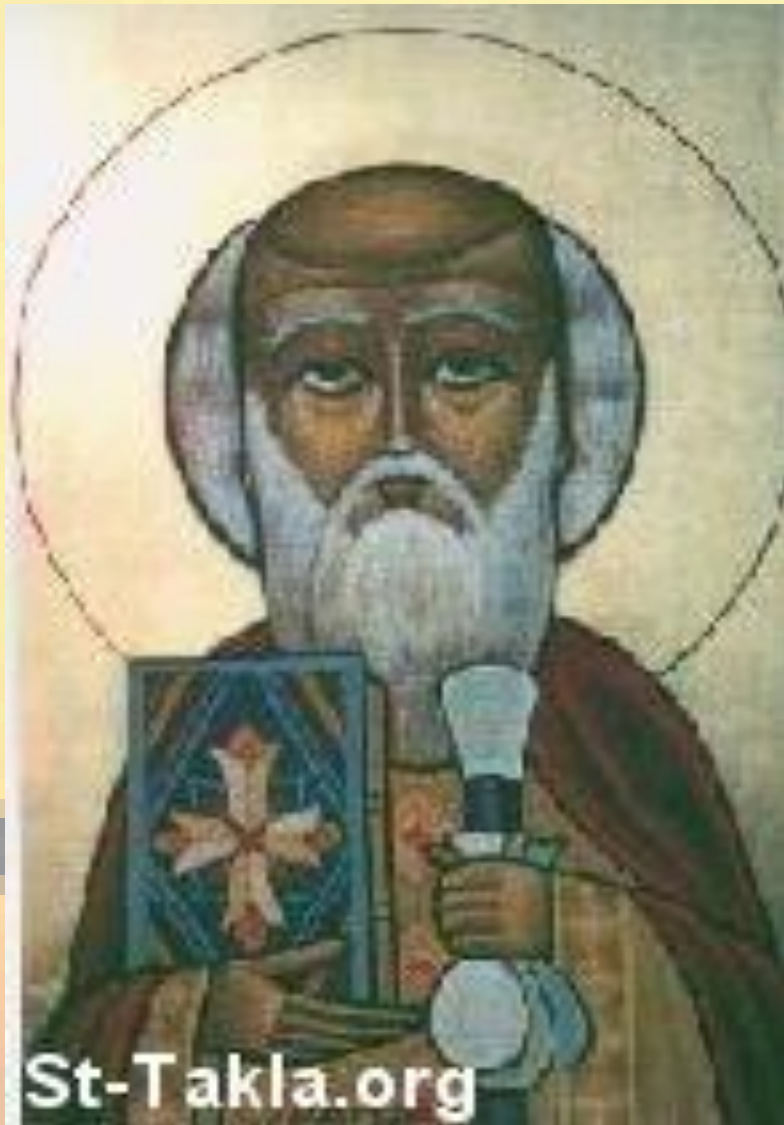
- He found it to be the kind bishop St. Nicholas

 - Share what we have with others.

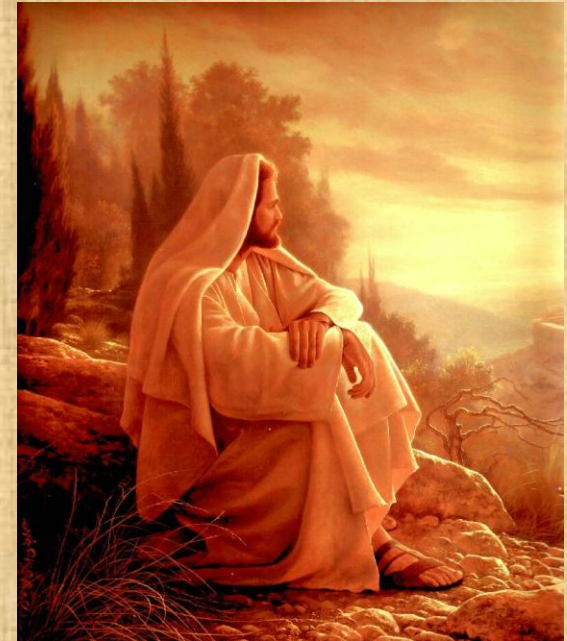
